Initial Network Management Guide, 5-1-2024

The network management information provided below is intended to provide further information regarding Utilities Board of the City of Sylacauga network management practices.

Utilities Board of the City of Sylacauga, (SUB) FRN # 0001745603

SUB offers one Internet Access Services; Fiber-To-The-Premise

Fiber-To-The-Premise: packages are 50/50 Mbps, 300/300 Mbps and 1 Gigabit Up and Down

Congestion management

SUB does not participate in congestion management practices.

Bandwidth is provided on a per-line (not a per-device) basis. The speed of the service may vary based on network or Internet congestion, your computer and or router configurations.

Application-specific behavior

Except as noted below with respect to Spam and Broadcast Storm Controls, SUB does not block or rate-control specific protocols or protocol ports other than for security reasons as set forth below, modify protocol fields in ways not prescribed by the protocol standard, or otherwise inhibit or favor certain applications or classes of applications of traffic on our Internet access service.

Spam Controls:

- blocks inbound email from IP addresses and domains that are suspected sources of spam.

Broadcast Storm Controls:

- blocks inbound Broadcast Storms from IP addresses and domains that are flooding the network.

Email services provided by a SUB or a third party will be governed by the email provider's terms of service, as well as the email provider's applicable privacy, email, security and anti-spam policies.

Device attachment rules

You may attach any lawful device to the network as long as it does not harm the network or the provision of Internet access service, facilitate theft of service or a violate our terms of service, or harm other users of the service.

Security

SUB follows network security policies and practices intended to address threats to our network and customers. Online activity that violates our terms of service or otherwise is targeted at or threatens to undermine the integrity or normal operation of our networks or services, or the security of our networks or our customers, may result in suspension or termination of service. We reserve the right at any time to take action to protect the integrity and normal operation of our networks and to safeguard our customers from Internet threats, including fraud and other forms of abuse. Such actions may include, but are not limited to, blocking, redirecting, or rate-limiting traffic using specific protocols, delivered over specific protocol ports, or destined for particular domain names or IP addresses associated with malicious activity.

If you use a Wi-Fi-equipped router, that router may provide a capability for you to encrypt traffic transmitted between your wireless device and your Wi-Fi router. We urge you to use this encryption setting to protect your service from being accessed by people you don't know and haven't authorized to use your service. You are responsible for activity using your connection and you may be responsible for unlawful use by someone else -- like illegal downloading or uploading copyrighted material. Please note that Wi-Fi encryption does not encrypt traffic you send over the Internet -- it just provides encryption for the Wi-Fi portion of the communications path between your wireless device and your Wi-Fi-enabled in-home router.
